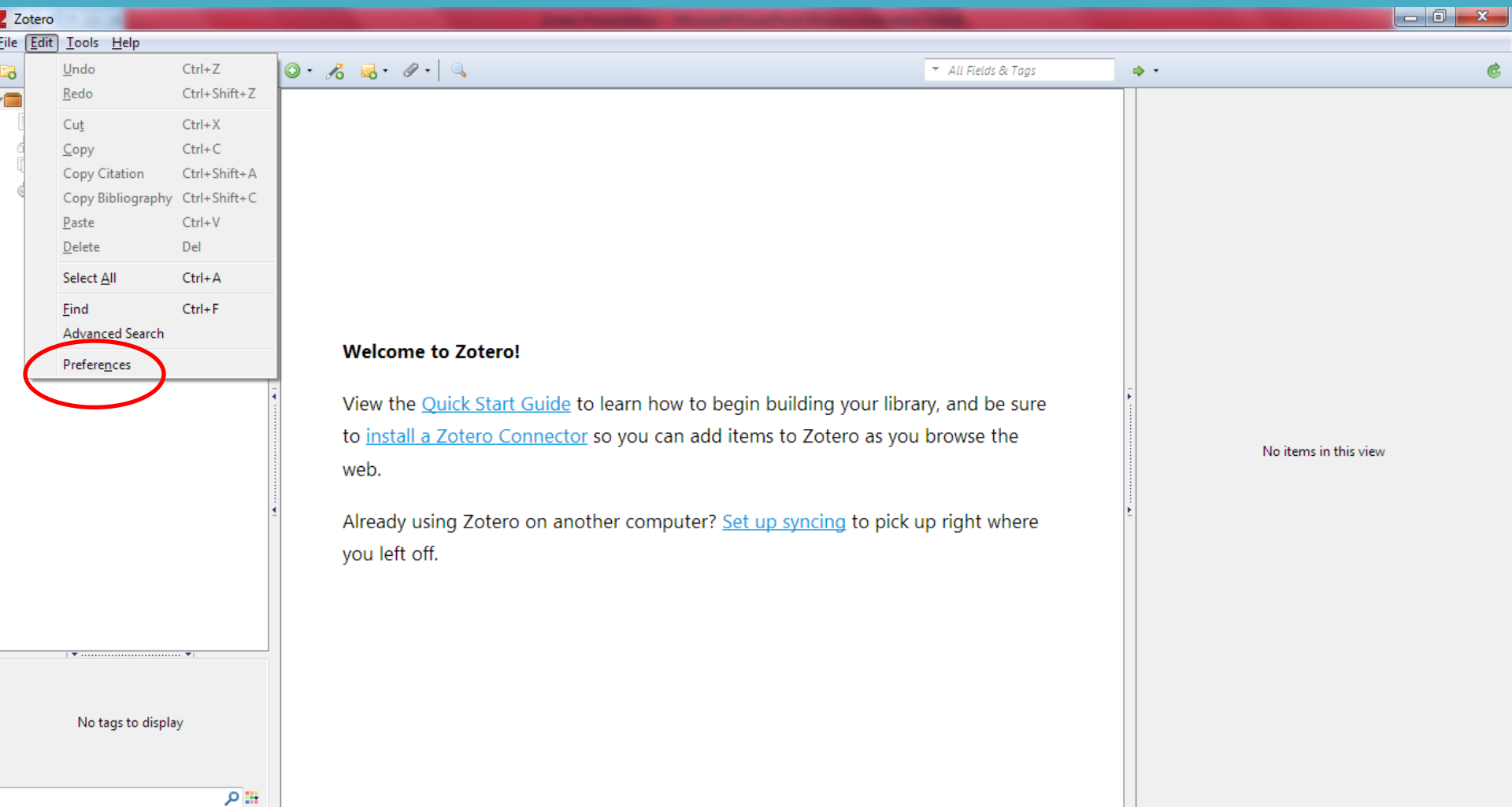
3- DRAG AND DROP PDF FILES FROM LOCAL HARD DISK

- Simply drag and drop various PDF files from computer hard disk in Zotero.
- Select all the files, right click and choose “Retrieve Metadata for PDFs”



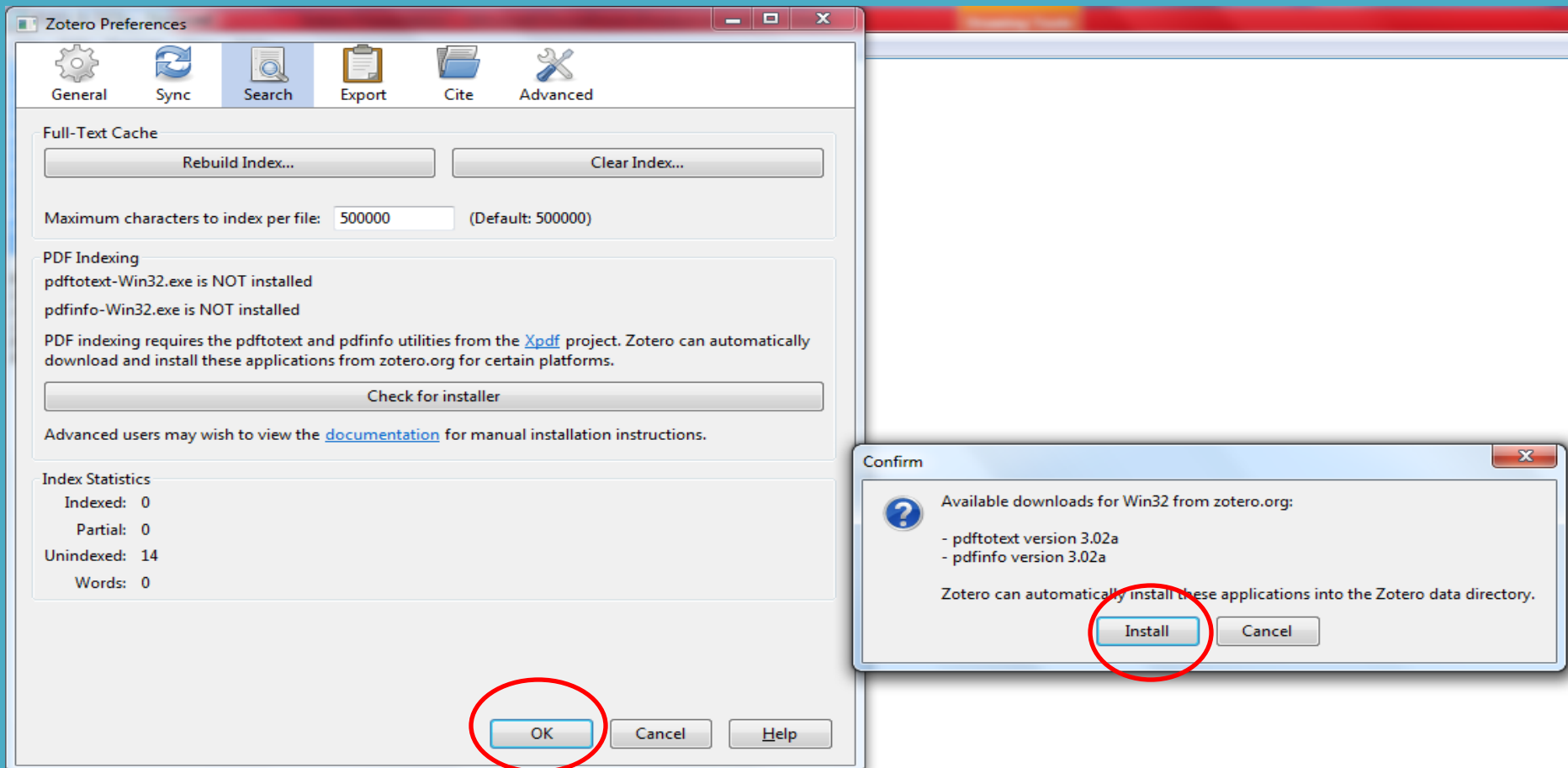
3- Drag and Drop PDF files from Local Hard Disk (Cont.)

- Click on “Edit” and choose “Preferences”



3- Drag and Drop PDF files from Local Hard Disk (Cont.)

You will prompt to install PDF tools, for this click on “Open Preferences” button and click on “Install” and then on OK



3- DRAG AND DROP PDF FILES FROM LOCAL HARD DISK (CONT.)

- Now again select all the PDFs, right click and choose “Retrieve Metadata for PDFs”
- Zotero will search online for available bibliographic details for PDFs and will display in Zotero references pan
- Zotero will leave any PDF(s) which have insufficient metadat to trace. Bibliographic data for such PDFs will have to search manually.

★ **Attach New Files to Zotero Items**
